DEQ Drought Warning

Your area is under a DEQ drought warning. This means conditions are worsening and your locality may be under water conservation. You should not be watering lawns, gardens, washing cars, or using excess water. Please take steps to conserve water. #DroughtWarning

DEQ Drought Emergency

Your area is under a DEQ drought emergency. This means you should not use excess water to wash your car, water gardens, or lawns. Please use water wisely in your home while brushing your teeth, washing dishes. Your local area might have mandatory water conservation in place. #DroughtEmergency
