What is Top Ops?

Top Ops is the “college bowl” of the water industry. Teams of one, two or three water operators or lab personnel from all AWWA Sections compete against each other in a fast-paced question-and-answer tournament. A moderator poses a broad range of technical questions and math problems, and the team scoring the most points in the championship round is awarded the Top Ops Championship.

Where is the 2025 Virginia Section AWWA Top Ops Competition Held?

The Virginia Section AWWA Top Ops is held at the annual Plant Operations Conference in Virginia Beach on April 30-May 2. A practice round is held on day 2 (May 1) and the final round is held on day 3 (May 2) of the conference.

What water professionals are eligible to compete?

Full-time water treatment plant or water distribution employees that hold a valid water operator, laboratory and/or distribution certification in their jurisdiction. Team members do not need to be employed by the same water authority.

What water professionals are not eligible to compete?

Senior employees with a job function higher than a first line supervisor and engineers unless they are actively working as a full-time operator.

How do I sign up?

Individuals or teams can sign up for Top Ops when registering for the Plant Operations Conference. Attending as an individual but want to compete on a team? No problem! We can match you with other individual competitors! There are no additional fees to compete.

Is it fun and what do the winners receive?

You bet it’s fun! The winning team receives an invitation to the national Top Ops competition held at the AWWA’s Annual Conference and Expo (ACE) and up to \$3000 towards ACE travel and expenses.
